

The majority of US residents, along with the international community, support an end to the US blockade against Cuba, as well as removing Cuba from the US State Sponsors of Terrorism List.

Every year the United Nations General Assembly votes overwhelmingly to condemn the extraterritorial US economic, commercial, and financial embargo against Cuba (Both 2023 and 2024 votes were 187 yes, 2 no, and 1 abstention.).

117 resolutions in support of the Cuban people, representing over 60 million U.S. people, have now been passed by U.S. City Councils, County Boards, State Legislatures, School Boards, Labor Councils, Labor Unions, Workers and other Organizations.

These resolutions have addressed:

Supporting ending the U.S embargo/blockade on Cuba

-Saving Lives through; scientific collaboration with Cuba on the Covid-19 Pandemic; donation of pacemakers to Cuba Urging that Cuba be removed from the U.S. List of State Sponsors of Terrorism (SSOT)

Many government bodies and labor unions have passed multiple resolutions regarding Ending the Embargo, Saving Lives, and/or Removing Cuba from SSOT list. This is indicated next to the name of each. In addition, elected officials have sent letters as a group with individual signatures to the President, Congressional delegations, and other officials. These letters are regarding U.S. policies towards Cuba. This list is at the end of this list of resolutions.
